HINT: Make yourself a cheat sheet with general crop data, i.e. Tomatoes take 8 weeks after planted in field for first harvest. X amount of days for seed to field ready plant, for each plant expect X lbs. of tomatoes and they are planted X plants per row, etc. An acre is 220'x220' / 43,560 square feet



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
