

## Attachment 2

We have assumed that the state contracts we have not read do *not* include a no-cost option, meaning that a maximum of 28 states could take advantage of a limited-time, 100 percent federal funding option for EBT-only equipment and service. Estimates are based on a leased equipment price of \$60 per month per device, the highest contract price we have found. The high price scenario assumes that every active FM/DMF in each state would take advantage of no-cost, EBT-only equipment if they knew it were available, which is unlikely. The low cost scenario is based only on FM/DMF that are losing a “free equipment” subsidy this year, and those whose equipment/service no longer works would take advantage of a no-cost, EBT-only option.
